






Background

All applicants will be assessed according to the following criteria:

- Currently leading peace development work (priority given)
- Community profile and challenges, levels of disadvantage/deprivation
- The current revenue streams including balance of trading income vs funding income.
- Future plans; key financial sustainability objectives and barriers to achieving these objectives
- Building connections; motivation to participate in a north/south social enterprise development and good relations programme.
- Key personnel, who will participate in the project i.e., staff and/or board representatives nominated to participate in the project.
- A profile of the social enterprise; aims, objectives, size, scale, purpose
